- Tuition is billed per credit; full time budget assumes enrollment in 9 credits in fall and spring, 6 in summer.
- Part time enrollment is 3 credits in the summer and 4.5 credits each in fall and spring. Full time enrollment is 6 credits in the summer and 9 credits each in fall and spring.
- All full-time students (registered for nine or more credits per semester – fall/spring) must either enroll in JHU’s health insurance plan or submit a waiver showing comparable health insurance coverage. All International students with an active F1 or J1 Visa status are ineligible to waive and must purchase the university plan. Dental and vision are optional for full-time students.
